

## 1200V 12A N-Channel Enhancement Mode Power MOSFET

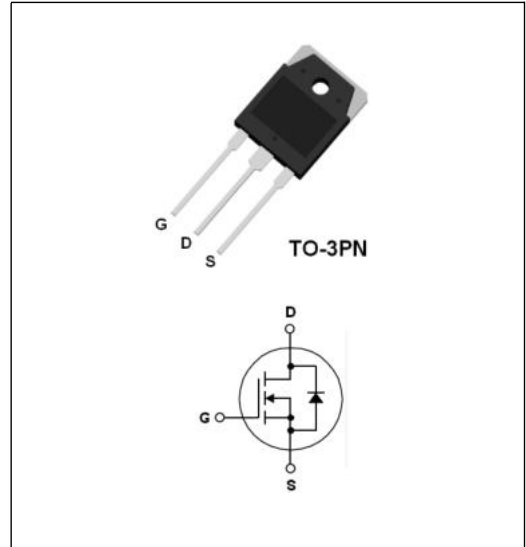
### Description

Fig. 1. Typical on-Region Characteristics

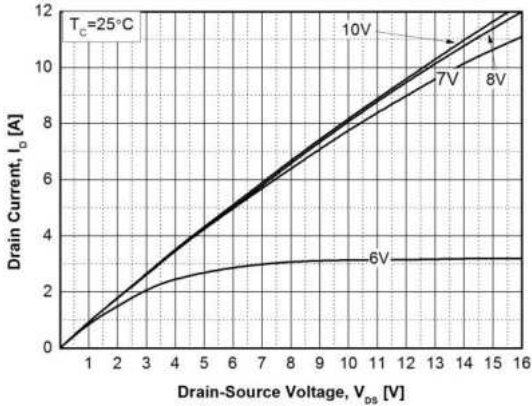


Fig. 2. Typical Transfer Characteristics

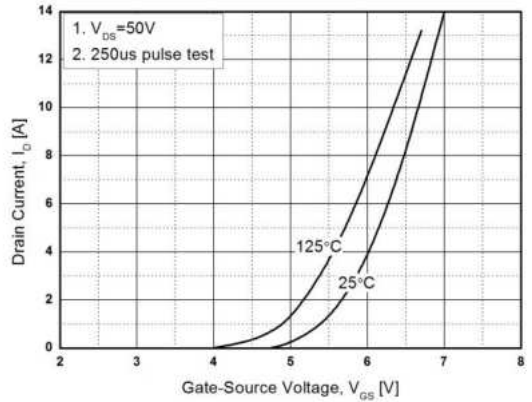


Fig. 3. Static on-Resistance vs.  $I_D$

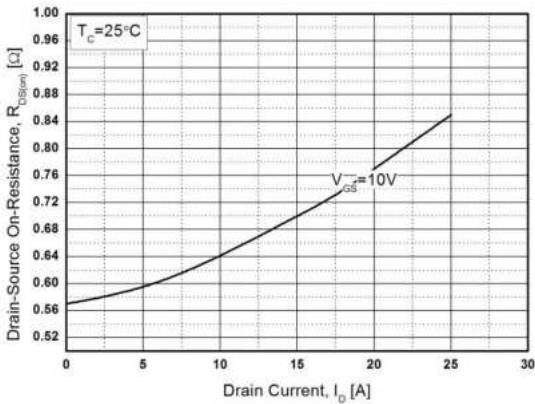


Fig. 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage vs.  $I_{DR}$

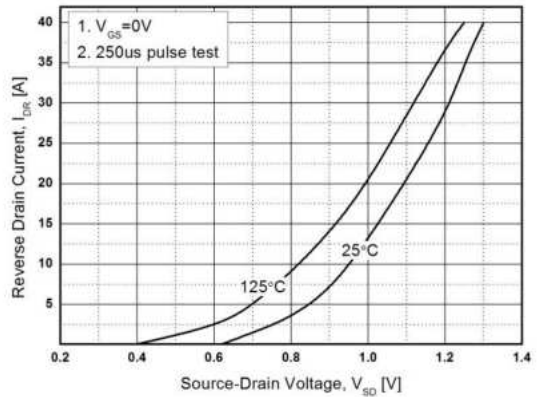


Fig. 5. Capacitance Characteristics

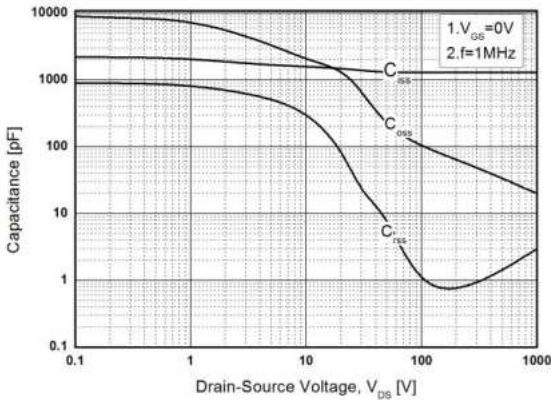
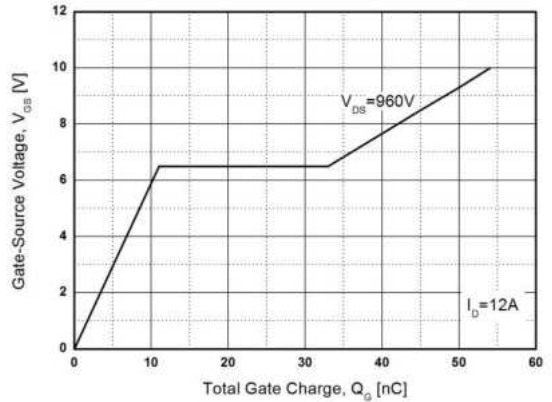


Fig. 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

Fig. 7. Breakdown Voltage vs. Temperature

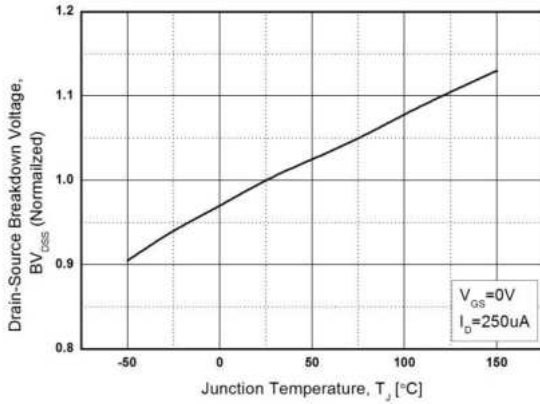


Fig. 8. Static on-Resistance vs. Temperature

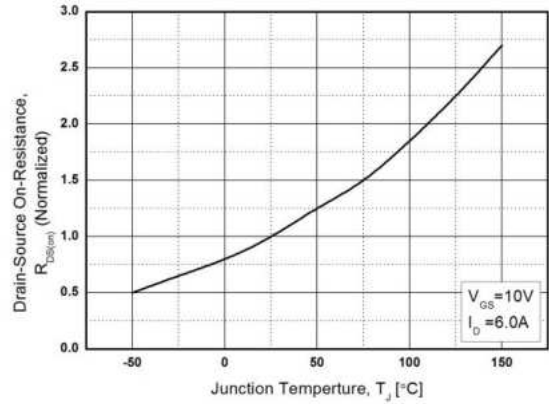


Fig. 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area

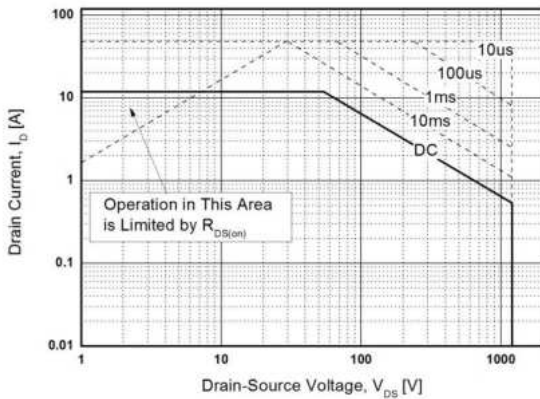


Fig. 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Temperature

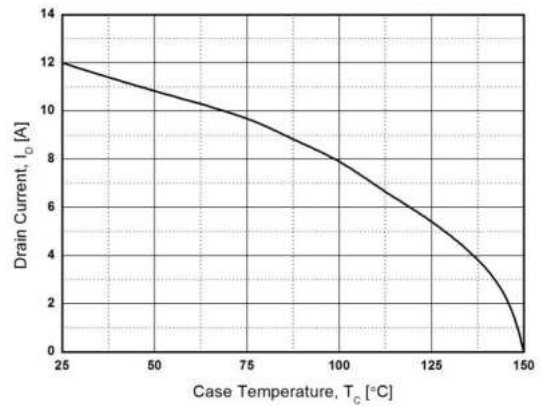
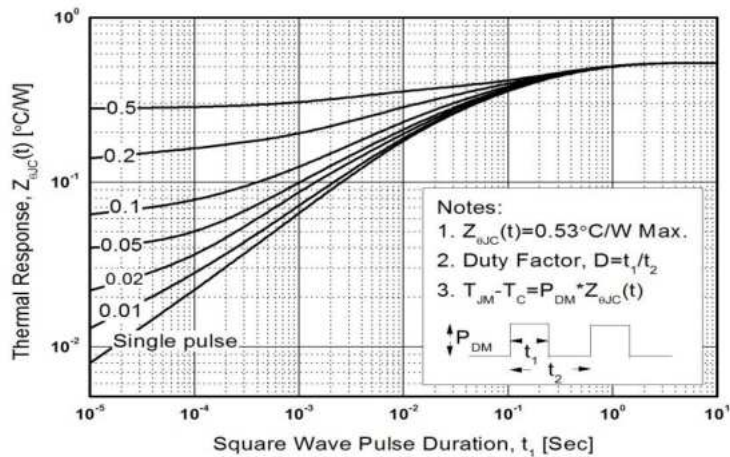


Fig. 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve
